GIFT AID FORM

If you use Gift Aid, you can make your donation worth more. For every pound you give to us, we can claim an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue.

So just fill in your details and return to our Treasurer below. It is that simple!
(If you've already sent us this Form with a previous donation, then you don't need to fill it in again.)

I declare that I am a UK taxpayer and I want the James Gibb Stuart Trust to treat all my donations from the following date// as Gift Aid donations until further notice.

Please note, you will need to pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax equal to the tax we claim on your donations (currently 25p for every £1 you give, as below).

I confirm that I pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax deducted from these donations in the appropriate tax year and I undertake to tell the James Gibb Stuart Trust if this becomes no longer true. A tax year is 6 April one year to 5 April the next.

If you do not complete a Self Assessment, you can use form P810 Tax Review available from your Tax Office.
